THE FACTS

Each week, the Food Bank fills more than 13,000 requests for emergency food assistance in Columbiana, Mahoning and Trumbull counties.

In 2010, the Food Bank distributed 8.4 million pounds of food in the tri-county area – 1 million pound increase over the previous year.

For every \$1.00 given, the Food Bank can distribute \$15.00 worth of food.

HOW THE FOOD BANK WORKS

Second Harvest Food Bank distributes food to 153 hunger-relief organizations in Columbiana, Mahoning and Trumbull counties. They include:

- After-school programs

The Food Bank operates Backpack Programs in Campbell and Warren that provide 300 children with food for the weekend.

The Food Bank operates Mobile Pantry Programs in Lake Milton and in Goshen and Ellsworth Townships.
