

Frequently Asked Questions

What is Harvest for Hunger?

Harvest for Hunger is a food and funds drive to help stock the Food Bank shelves for the spring and summer months when donations taper off. Harvest for Hunger takes place in 21 counties of Northeast Ohio.

Is my donation tax deductible?

Yes. All contributions to the Harvest for Hunger campaign are fully tax deductible as allowed by law. Receipts will be sent to the donor by the Food Bank at the conclusion of the drive.

*Please note - If anyone needs to be receipted individually, please compile a list and include first and last name, address, phone number and amount given. Otherwise, donations will be receipted to the company that hosted the funds drive.

Do you prefer cash or food donations?

For every \$1 given, the Food Bank can distribute \$10 worth of food or the equivalent of 5 meals. However, food donations are always needed.
